ELIGIBILITY

- Unmarried male citizen of Pakistan
- Age as on 31st December 2022: Not more than 20 years; For ex-FATA/Gilgit-Baltistan/AJK/Balochistan not more than 21 years (1 year age relaxation)
- Minimum Height: 5 feet 4 inches

ACADEMIC QUALIFICATION

- The candidates must have passed F.Sc Pre Engineering or O/A Level with Subject combination (Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics) having at least 55% marks;
- Candidates of O/A Level are to submit Equivalence Certificate;
- F.Sc/ A Level Part-II appearing candidates with at least 60% in Part-I can also apply. However, they have to provide Hope Certificate from the head of respective college/ institute.
- If a candidate fails to attain 55% marks in F.Sc after providing hope certificate, he will be disqualified at any stage of selection process or discharged during training.

Submit application form through Courier Services along with pay order/bank draft of Rs. 3000/- in-favour of Pakistan Marine Academy, Karachi, National Bank of Pakistan(NBP), PMA Branch Code-0239. Candidates applying under Self Finance Scheme (SFS) are to submit additional pay order/bank draft for Rs.300,000/- along with the application form. SFS fee will be refunded in case selected on open-merit or do not meet PMA eligibility criteria.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- Entrance Test will be conducted at Abbottabad, Gwadar Karachi, Lahore, Multan, Muzaffarabad(AJK), Peshawar, Quetta, Rawalpindi, Sukkur through hired Testing Agencies.
- Minimum 50% is required to qualify in entrance test.
- Medical examination of short listed candidates will be conducted at designated Army/Navy/PAF Hospitals.
- Final selection will be done in order of merit which include F.Sc. Marks, Entry Test Marks PET, Medical & final interview. PET and interview will be conducted after Entry Test Results.
- Final Interview and PET dates will be updated on PMA website and same will be communicated to candidate.

INELIGIBILITY

- ❖ Dismissed/ Removed/ Debarred/ Resigned from Government Service including Armed Forces
- ❖ Convicted by a court of law for offence involving moral turpitude
- ❖ Non-Combination of Subjects and Diploma holder (DAE) are not eligible
- ❖ Declared Medically unfit by an Armed Forces hospital/Appeal Medical Board
- ❖ Candidates Declared **COLOUR BLIND**.
