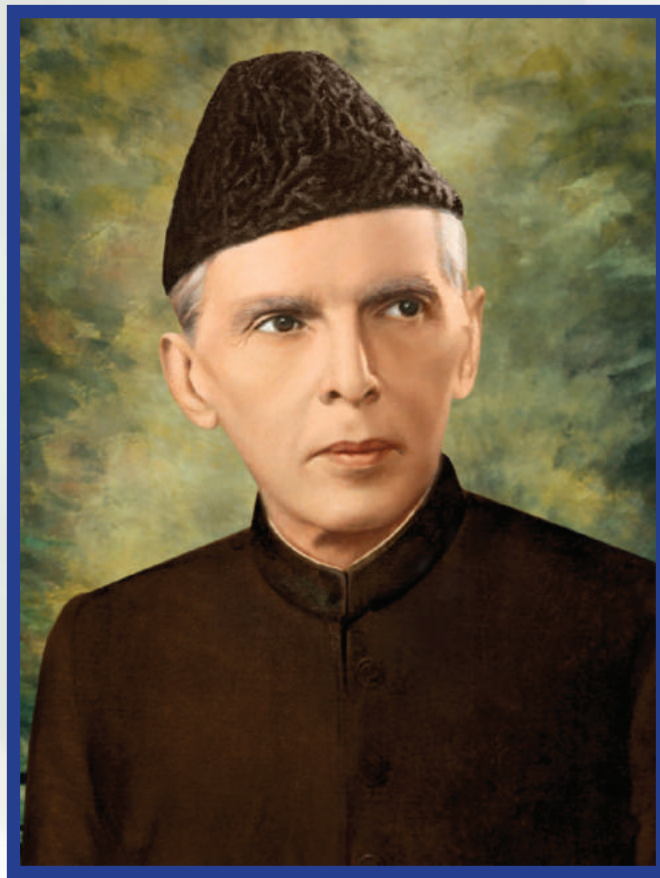

Initially, Academy provided pre-sea training to Cadets of Nautical and Engineering Branches; first batch of 41 Cadets graduated in 1964. In 1971, PMA was re-established at Karachi.

Why to Join PMA?

Maritime sector is composed of organizations and activities such as maritime transportation/Merchant navy; ports & harbors; naval engineering; shipbuilding; commercial fishing; aquaculture industry; cruise; recreational sector; sports; marinas; marine energy sources; marine & ocean research sciences; maritime training academies/training centers, etc.

Shipping or the Merchant Navy has long been the major form of transportation, as well as an essential communication link connecting coastal cities, countries and continents. Next to rail transportation, water transportation is economically and environmentally the most efficient way to travel or transport merchandise.

The Merchant Navy is made up of a large number of shipping companies operating many different types and size of ship, from container ships, to chemical carriers, to oil rig supply vessels. Career at Sea

Merchant Navy Cadet/Officer are employed on the many type of vessels, that include container ships; bulk cargo ships, oil/ gas/chemical tankers; supply, support and rescue vessels, ferries/cruise ships etc. As an officer/ Cadet, one works in either deck or engineering department.

Nautical (Deck) Cadet/Officer

Nautical / Deck Cadets are trained to handle a ship and also to navigate her safely from one point to another. At PMA during training, theoretical and practical knowledge is imparted in Navigation, Chart Work, Meteorology, Ship Stability, Cargo Operations, Shipping Law and various mandatory IMO approved safety courses. After graduating from PMA, you will start your career as Deck Cadet whose main duties include: to navigate vessel using a range of satellite & radar systems and equipment; to check weather & navigation reports and take appropriate actions; to coordinate safe loading, storage and unloading of cargo; to manage care and safety of passengers (on a ferry/cruise ship); to supervise operation and maintenance of deck machinery, e.g. winches and cranes; to manage ship communication systems; to monitor & maintain safety, firefighting and life-saving equipment; to oversee ship for ensuring that highest levels of health and safety are maintained; to maintain legal and operational records such as ship's log; keep up to date with developments in maritime legal, commercial and political matters, etc.



Engineering Cadet/Officer

As an engineering Cadet/Officer, you'll need to operate and maintain mechanical and electrical equipment on board; manage power generation and distribution systems, as well as refrigeration plant, ventilation and pumping systems; monitor, repair and upgrade systems and equipment, e.g. air compressors, pumps and sewage plants; implement regular equipment inspections and maintenance programmes; keep up to date with developments in the marine engineering field.

Training Facilities

Seasoned professionals and state of the art training infrastructure are hallmarks of PMA.

PMA is equipped with requisite state-of-the-art training infrastructure, that include Full Mission Bridge simulator connected with Engine-room simulator; Electronic Chart Display & Information System (ECDIS), Global Maritime Distress & Safety System (GMDSS), Radio Detection and Ranging (RADAR) Automatic Radar Plotting Aid (ARPA) and High Voltage (HV) simulators; well-equipped science laboratories, engineering workshops, Fire-fighting mock-up; a well-stocked library and a modern computer & language lab. In addition, there are indoor/outdoor sports facilities/fields, swimming pool, auditorium, parade ground and a pier (jetty) for water-borne training facilities.

All the facilities are used to train the young seafarers professionally and physically for performing future responsibilities.

Co curricular Activities

At PMA, training philosophy revolves around, 'Producing Best for the Future', therefore, classroom activities and physical training are coupled together to reinforce various facet of personality development and inculcate Seafarer character traits like: outgoing, active, energetic, assertive, enthusiastic and competitive. Co-curricular activities are designed to create impact in all domains of life such as cognitive (intellectual), emotional, social, moral, cultural and aesthetic. Competitiveness, excellence, quality achievements, creativeness and enthusiasm are few of the ethics of extra-curricular activities.

During course of training at PMA, opportunities are provided to Cadets for participation in indoor and outdoor sports, within the Academy as well participation in various competitions at University/College levels. Infrastructural Facilities

Admin Block

Admin block is comprised of administrative and educational/training facilities, which include offices, class rooms, laboratories, library, simulators, auditorium, canteen etc. and lodging arrangements.

Cadets' Block

A fully furnished accommodation is available for the Cadets. The accommodation fulfills necessary boarding and lodging arrangements. Facilities provided in the Cadet Block include: Cadets' dining hall, TV rooms, Cable TV & Wifi, Computer room, Gymnasium, Tailor Shop, Tuck Shop, Guest Room, Laundry, Barbershop, Indoor games room, etc.

Mosque

Regular prayers are held at our on-campus mosque that has a capacity to accommodate about one thousand persons.

Health Care Centre

Qualified Staff is present at the medical center to deal with emergencies on Campus and provides basic treatment and first aid. Depending on the severity of illness, patients may be referred to other hospitals for further treatment.

Auditorium

A purpose built auditorium with a seating capacity of more than 300 persons is available. Necessary audio visual equipments are installed to conduct various events.

How to Apply

- PMA conducts 2 years training in the disciplines of Nautical and Engineering sciences under Open Merit and Self Finance Schemes. 150 Seats are allocated for Open Merit and 20 seats for Self Finance Scheme.
- Prospectus and admission form may be obtained from the Academy in person, or by post/mail. The same may also be downloaded from PMA website www.marineacademy.edu.pk
- Candidates who are waiting for result may also apply but their admission will be subject to timely submission of the result.
- Candidates from A Level System are also to submit equivalence certificate (Pre-Engineering Group), obtained from Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC), Pakistan.

Eligibility Criteria

Unmarried male citizen of Pakistan.

Age: Not more than 20 years as on 31st Dec of applying; For FATA/ Gilgit-Baltistan / AJK / Balochistan, not more than 21 years as on 31st Dec of applying.

Qualification

Higher Secondary School Certificate: Pre-Engineering/equivalent in Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics with at least 55% Marks.

Candidates who are awaiting final results may also apply, however, they have to provide a 'Hope Certificate' from head of respective College/ Institute.

Scholarships

33 Scholarships for 2 years course under Ministry of Maritime Affairs and 04 from GRG(GREEP), are offered on need-based to deserving Cadets; distribution of MoMA scholarships is as under: Baluchistan: 15; Punjab/ AJK: 06; Sindh: 06; KPK/ex-FATA: 06

How To Register

Prospectus & application forms are available with PMA admission office and on PMA website.

Submit application form along with pay order/bank draft of Rs. 2500/- in favor of Pakistan Marine Academy, Karachi, NBP, PMA Branch, FTN: 9010261-1. Candidates applying under SFS are to submit additional pay order/bank draft for Rs. 300,000/- along with the application form. SFS fee will be refunded in case selected on open-merit.

Declared medically unfit by Medical Board.

Rules & Regulations for SFS Scheme

Candidates applying for admission under SFS must fulfill all the eligibility

criteria as laid down for admission under the regular scheme:

They must enclose a Pay Order / Demand Draft of Rs. 300,000/- (Rupees Three hundred thousand only) with the application for admission under SFS.

Candidates for admission under SFS shall be required to qualify the Entrance Test, Medical Fitness Examination and interview.





Selection Procedure

After last date of submission of Admission Forms, Admit Cards for Entrance Test will be sent to eligible Candidates;

A merit list of qualified Candidates will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in entrance test and HSC/A-Level.

Short listed candidates will be notified with date of medical examination in the Military Hospitals, designated by the Academy at expense of Candidates.

Candidates will arrange their boarding and lodging. The candidates will travel at their own expense to and from the place of medical examination. No TA/DA will be admissible.

Candidates qualifying medical tests will forward copy of their complete medical examination reports to the Academy, immediately.

A list of medically fit candidates will be prepared and called for interview on the designated dates and place.

The list of finally selected candidates will be displayed on the Campus notice board as well on PMA's web site: www.marineacademy.edu.pk.

PMA Admission Office will issue joining instructions to the finally selected candidates. However, applicants are advised to remain in contact with PMA regarding status of their application or regularly visit PMA's website.

Candidates are to report to Academy on the specified date.

Candidates will undergo Eye-Sight and Colour Vision Test conducted by Mercantile Marine Department(MMD) at Karachi, after joining the Academy. These tests will be in addition to the normal Medical Examinations.

It is mandatory for the candidates to qualify MMD Eye-sight and Colour Vision tests. If a candidate fails in these tests, his admission will be cancelled.

A reasonable number of eligible candidates (in accordance with the merit list) will be placed on the waiting list. They will be called up in case selected ones do not report in time or for any other reasons.

Appropriate number of candidates will be recruited for Nautical and Engineering Branches. Due consideration will be given to candidate's choice but the Academy may award specific branch based on medical fitness, general suitability, academic record, market needs and availability of seats etc.

Entrance Test

The entrance test will be conducted by a reputable testing agency at Gwadar, Karachi, Lahore, Multan, Muzaffarabad, Peshawar, Quetta, Rawalpindi and Sukkar.

The Entrance Test will be held for applicants in the following subjects: (Intermediate Level)

- a. English b. Physics c. Mathematics d. IQ

Minimum 45% marks are required to qualify the Entrance Test.

Candidates will make their own boarding and lodging arrangement for the Entrance Test and will travel at their own expenses. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates.

You are allowed to bring along clipboard, pencils, eraser and sharpener only.

You are not allowed to use any device which could assist in calculation such as calculator, tables, digital watch, mobile phone, electron diary, Palm Pilot, Bluetooth, hands free devices, etc. inside the examination centre.



Answer sheets are marked through computer, therefore, it is important that the candidates read and understand these instructions thoroughly before taking the exam. Non-compliance will affect scoring adversely.

There is no negative marking.

Write your Roll No on the front page of the Question Book.

Use your time effectively. Do not spend too much time on one question, otherwise you will run short of time for other questions.

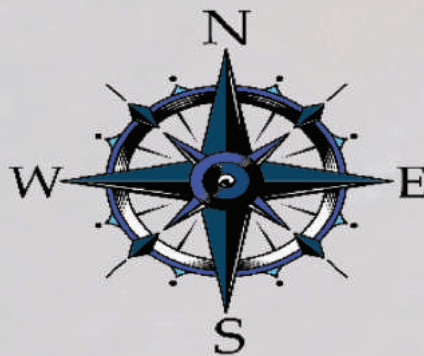
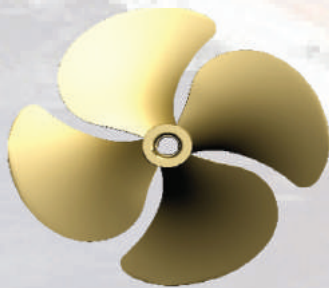
